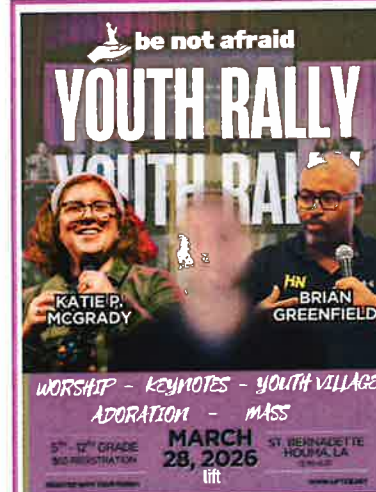
There are not enough words to fully express our heartfelt gratitude for the support of so many who made the Bishop's visit a wonderful experience! St. Andrew's
