



Bridget would like to apologize for not placing the 2026 calendars in the back of Church last week as promised. They are there now and available for pick up. Sorry for the inconvenience.






There are not enough words to fully express our heartfelt gratitude for the support of so many who made the Bishop's visit a wonderful experience! St. Andrew's
