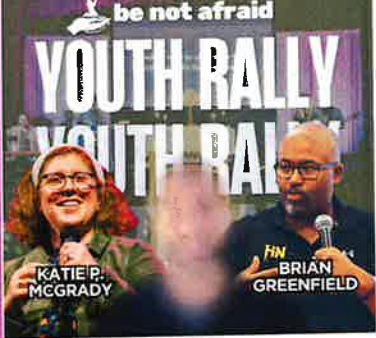
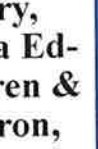
Mr. Fred's service will be held at St. Andrew on Friday, February 6th from 9:00 am until Mass at 11:00 am.
