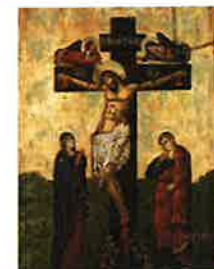

A rare relic of St. John Paul II's liquefied blood will be traveling in our diocese from September 18-21, a wonderful opportunity for prayer and veneration. The relic is one of four relics containing the liquefied blood of St. John Paul II and the only one designated as a traveling relic. The relic is a small glass vial mounted on an ornate book resembling an open lectionary. It has been made available by the Sisters of the Servants of the Pierced Hearts of Jesus and Mary, who have custody of the relic from the Holy See. The relic will be present for Masses and periods of public veneration at the following locations:

6:30-9:30 p.m. — Veneration of the relic

Saturday, September 19 only private viewings

Sunday, September 20 at the Cathedral of St. Francis de Sales

Noon-4 p.m. — Veneration of the relic at the Cathedral of St. Francis de Sales

Sunday, September 20 at Our Lady of the Rosary in Larose

5 p.m. — Holy Mass

6-9 p.m. — Veneration of the relic

Monday, September 21 at Christ the Redeemer

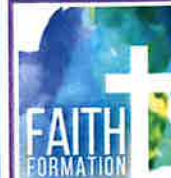
