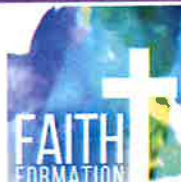

A rare relic of St. John Paul II's liquefied blood
will be traveling in our diocese from September
18-21, a wonderful opportunity for prayer and
veneration. The relic is one of four relic-
s containing the liquefied blood of St. John
Paul II and the only one designated as a travel-
ing relic. The relic is a small glass vial mounted
on an ornate book resembling an open lection-
ary. It has been made available by the Sisters of
the Servants of the Pierced Hearts of Jesus and
Mary, who have custody of the relic from the
Holy See. The relic will be present for Masses
and periods of public veneration at the follow-
ing locations:

8 a.m.-4 p.m. — Veneration of the relic

**Monday, September 21 at St. Joseph Co-
Cathedral, Thibodaux**

ic Veneration"

6:30-9:30 p.m. — Veneration of the relic
